Meeting II in 2025 | 7 May 2025 at 13:00-14:00 UTC

SUMMARY REPORT

Action items:

1. The second virtual meeting in 2025 of the Policy Network on Artificial Intelligence (PNAI) Multistakeholder Working Group (MWG) took place online on 7 May 2025 at 13:00 UTC.
2. The meeting was hosted by the three MAG facilitators of the PNAI, Amrita Choudhury, Audace Niyonkuru, Xiao Zhang, and the IGF Secretariat's PNAI Consultant Maikki Sipinen. The final version of the Agenda is attached to this document as Annex A1 and a list of meeting participants as Annex A2. The list of shared documents is annexed as A3.
3. The hosts opened the call and shared a brief status of activities. PNAI's 2025 work plan and a proposal to continue PNAI were drafted and approved by MAG in the beginning of the year. The main purpose of the meeting was to confirm PNAI's 2025 goals and start preparations of PNAI Webinar and Main Session at IGF 2025 Annual Meeting.
4. PNAI's two key goals for 2025 were presented. Based on the Work Plan, the Policy Network will suggest a plan on how the IGF can maximize its impact as central multistakeholder platform for AI discussion. The end deliverable will be a report to be published in November. The second goal is to engage in key AI discussions and forums. This will be achieved through PNAI key messages and a list of international AI forums that should hear them. The meeting attendees agreed with these goals and plans.
5. PNAI will host a Webinar on **3.6.2025 at 13:00 UTC** to discuss IGF's role and impact in global AI dialogue and how to improve AI synergies inside the IGF. The hosts presented a draft concept.

- Meeting attendees supported the idea and highlighted for example the importance of including local communities, promoting sharing best practices, systematic engagement, and IGF's role as the only accessible global bottom-up process on AI. Additional PNAI webinars can be organized to gather input for the report, this could be discussed after IGF 2025.
 - Maikki will send the concept note for everyone's comments. A group of volunteers (Amado Espinosa, Yik Chan Chin, Constance Bommelaer de Leusse, Sana Nisar, Murillo Romano Salvador and Henrietta Ampofo) was formed to organize the webinar.
6. Plans for PNAI key messages and engaging in international AI dialogues were presented. A set of standardised speaking points will be drafted, and a list of AI forums will be created. It is important to build on earlier PNAI work and reports. Two volunteer groups were formed to start working on these and will report on their progress in the next PNAI MWG meeting.
7. PNAI will organize a Main Session at IGF 2025 in June. The hosts presented a draft session concept including for example policy questions, speakers and flow.
- The session will be part of the process to gather input for the report, and it should build on the Webinar input. The preliminary policy questions in the Main Session concept note can be edited after the Webinar. PNAI's session should not overlap with the AI-themed MAG session.
 - The concept note will be sent to PNAI mailing lists for further comments and speaker suggestions after the meeting. The small group of volunteers organizing the Webinar will finalize the note based on the comments latest on **12.5**.

Other and next steps

8. A meeting summary, materials and presentations will be shared through the PNAI mailing list.
9. Maikki will share the Main Session concept note for comments through PNAI mailing list after the call. Everyone is welcome to add comments by **Saturday 10.5**. A group of volunteers will finalize the note on 12.5.
10. Maikki will share the Webinar concept note for comments through PNAI mailing list after the call. Everyone is welcome to add comments to the Google document by **Sunday 11.5**.
11. A group of volunteers will finalize the Main session concept on **12.5**. and start preparing the Webinar. PNAI members with interest and time to volunteer are welcome to email Maikki.
12. Two volunteer groups will start developing the Key messages and List of AI forums. They will report back to the PNAI MWG meeting. Maikki will send the name list gathered in the meeting to PNAI mailing list, those still willing to join can email Maikki.
13. PNAI Webinar will take place on **Tuesday 3.6.2025** at **13:00 UTC**
